



QLD S100 HIV Co-payment Program



Program Information

What is the QLD s100 HIV Co-payment Program?

The QLD s100 HIV Co-payment Program helps Queensland residents living with HIV by waiving the co-payments when they receive section 100 HIV antiretroviral therapy (ART) medication at QLD community pharmacies. Pharmacies are not permitted to charge these patients the co-payment when dispensing eligible s100 HIV medications.

What you need to know

When an eligible patient presents a prescription for s100 HIV ART medication at your pharmacy, ask them to **sign the 3-year Patient Consent Form** and then **waive the co-payment** for the patient.

Your pharmacy can submit eligible patient co-payment claims for reimbursement to the Pharmacy Guild of Australia via the online Claiming and Payment Portal. In addition to a Service Fee of **\$2.23** (incl GST) per co-payment claimed, there is a one-time monthly Administration Fee of **\$13.42** (incl GST), which is paid along with the first claim made each month.

Patient and Medicine eligibility

To be eligible for this program, the patient must meet the following eligibility criteria:

Patient eligibility:

- Must be a QLD resident who is Medicare eligible, and
- Must be a patient of QLD public hospitals, sexual health clinics, or authorised community prescribers in QLD for the s100 HIV ART medications

Medicine eligibility:

- HIV antiretroviral therapy medicine under PBS s100 HSD Community Access
- Prescription must have authority prescription number and, streamlined authority code

If you are unsure whether the medicine is eligible, head to www.pbs.gov.au and type the medicine in the search box at the top right corner to make sure it's s100 Community Access HIV ART medicine.
